## Task 1 - Student Profile

Create a profile all about you:

1. Introduction – who are you, what do you like to do in your spare time (eg hobbies, social activities, etc), which school you have come from and what are some of your interests. Include a photograph if you would like to
2. GCSE exam results – what are you hoping to achieve at GCSE? Include any other relevant information that you think might be useful for us to know, eg did you have any access requirements, eg extra time, reader, etc?
3. Extra-curricular activities – what have you done outside of school? Do you have a part-time job? Are you a member of a sports team, social group, etc?

5. Career aims – what do you want to do with the course? (Don't worry if you are unsure – just write down some careers you would be interested in)
6. What personal skills and qualities do you feel you have that make you a suitable person to work with children and young people?
7. Universities – I would like you to research and find out information about two universities you might be interested in, this needs to include UCAS points/entry requirements for courses you think you might be interested in attending after you leave sixth form

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) is the learning and education framework for children from birth to the end of Reception year.
