



Travel Information to get to Scarborough Sixth Form

IMPORTANT – For all young persons aged 18 or under they will pay only £1 for a single journey on most bus routes in North Yorkshire including EYMS, Arriva and the Coastliner 843 service. They will need to ask the driver for the fare as it will not always be given automatically

Q How can I get to college?

A The options will depend on where you live:

- Walking
- College bus for the Whitby, Bridlington, Drifffield and Helmsley & Pickering areas
- North Yorkshire County Council Bus
- Public transport i.e. trains & buses
- Drive if you have a car
- Cycling
- Motorcycle

Q How do I pay for the college buses?

A For a college pass you will need to buy a bus pass from the college. Student Services will send you a link to apply. A yearly bus pass cost £600.00 which you purchase from WisePay as unfortunately we don't have a direct debit system. You can pay:

- In six instalments - £200.00 deposit and five payments of £80.00
- One payment of £600

For a NYCC bus pass you need to go the website:

www.northyorks.gov.uk/post16transport

- The cost of the pass is £846.00 and your parents will need to set up a direct debit to either pay in full or set up monthly payments

Please note, the NYCC annual bus pass may not be your cheapest option, so investigate all your options.

Q Can I pay daily on the college bus and NYCC buses?

A No, you can only travel on the college or NYCC bus with a current academic pass

Q How often do the NYCC and college buses run?

A They run once in the morning and once in the afternoon and if you miss your bus you will need to make your own way into college or home. In the morning, the buses run to get you into college before the lessons start from 09:00 am and the afternoon buses run after 16:00 pm when college lessons finish

Q Can I get financial assistance to travel into college?

A Yes if:

- Your household income is below £35,000 per year and receiving Universal Credit – you can apply for the 16-19 Bursary Fund for financial support towards the cost of travel
- For families that are over the £35,000 threshold but under £40,000 and receiving Universal Credit, students can apply for a discount towards a college/NYCC travel pass
- If you use public transport i.e. buses. you can apply for assistance by completing a financial support application if you live more than 3 miles from the college and the cost is more than £600.00 per academic year
- If you are unsure if you are eligible, please speak to Student Service who will be able to advise you
- Travel to Learn – if you get 7 or above in GCSE Maths & English (English Language only) you can apply for a travel to learn which will cover your travel costs of £600.00

Q If I drive where can I park?

A The college has a car park, and you will need to register your car or motorcycle with Student Services. Spaces are not guaranteed and if the car park is full you will need to park elsewhere. Please be aware the college is in a residential area, and you will need to park elsewhere respectively.

Q Can I get a refund if I decide to drive or if I decide to leave college later in the academic year?

Yes, for college & NYCC bus pass purchased through the college but no refunds are given after the 1st of April – your refund amount will depend on when you decide you no longer require your pass. You must hand in your bus pass to Student Services to cancel it and get a refund. If you applied direct to NYCC for a pass, then you would need to apply to NYCC direct before the 1st April for a refund
